Dear Parents and Carers,

The National Education Union (NEU) is still planning to hold strikes this week, on Wednesday 15 March and Thursday 16 March 2023.

The teachers are not required to tell their employers whether they intend to take strike action, which makes it very difficult to plan in advance which classes will be able to remain open and which classes will unfortunately have to close for these two days.

We understand how disruptive this is for our families and ask for your support and understanding as we try to give you as much notice as possible of any disruption to the school.

For the classes that remain open, there may also be disruption. Where possible we will use our staff that are not striking to supervise classes, however the school are unable to ask staff to cover the teacher if that is not within a teacher or Teaching Assistant's usual roles, which is why some classes must be closed.

Please check below if your child's class will remain open on Wednesday and Thursday:

The following classes will be **closed** and the children **will not attend school**:

Reception – Ash and Yew

Year 2 – 2M and 2V

Year 4 – 4M and 4P

Year 6 – 6J and 6M

The following classes will be **open** and attend school as usual:

Nursery – Willow

Year 1 – 1K, 1O and 1T

Year 3 – 3H and 3O

Year 5 – 5L and 5M (The year 5 trips will also go ahead as planned)

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
